#### 2 Thessalonians 2:1-12

#### **Opening Comments**

- Welcome to the FUTURE TODAY prophecy meeting
- We are living in very strange and confusing times
- For example, last week about 12 thousand women exercised their basic human right to seek help from women's reproductive health professionals they call it a social good
- That confuses me because 12 thousand babies died for the 'good' of their mothers we call that abortion evil

• We are living in the times Isaiah said would come <u>Isaiah 5:20-21</u> Woe to those who call evil good, and good evil; who put darkness for light, and light for darkness; who put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter! Woe to *those who are* wise in their own eyes, and prudent in their own sight!

- Even something as obvious as gender is now totally confused in the culture
- President Biden recently celebrated the appointment of a man as the first female 4-star admiral because this man says he thinks he is a woman
- What is going on in this world?
- Paul tells us turn to **2 Thessalonians 2**
- What we see going on today was predicted 2,500 years ago by Isaiah and explained 2,000 years ago by Paul
- This is one of the signs Jesus warned us would come before He returns for His church
- Paul writing to the church in Thessalonica

### • <u>2 Thessalonians 2:1-4</u>

- The church, which was experiencing persecution, was being told by some that it was a sign that they were in the Tribulation right before Jesus came back
- Paul says, no it is not!
- Before it happens there has to be a great turning away from the faith and the rise of the 'man of sin' the Antichrist
- That can't happen now because something else must happen first
- <u>2 Thessalonians 2:5-8</u>

#### THE FUTURE TODAY!

- Before the Antichrist is revealed and free to do Satan's ultimate will, the Restrainer, the Holy Spirit must stop restraining him and the evil he wishes to do
- That will happen at the Rapture of the church
- Once the Antichrist is no longer restrained by the Holy Spirit, Satan is going to empower him to rule the whole world
- <u>2 Thessalonians 2:9-10</u>
- God loves everyone He created and offers them salvation from the penalty of their sins through the atoning sacrifice of Christ on the cross
- Jesus on the cross is the truth of God's love
- But "they did not receive the love of the truth, that they might be saved..."
- By rejecting Jesus, they have rejected God and His truth
- Therefore, they won't be saved
- And there is a temporal penalty for rejecting the love of the truth
- <u>2 Thessalonians 2:11-12</u>
- Those who reject God's love and truth will be rewarded with God's punishment and judgment
- One of those punishments is 'God will send them strong delusion, that they should believe the lie'
- There are a couple of definitions for the word delusion
- Delusion: a belief that is not true: a false idea and: a false idea or belief that is caused by mental illness.
- For example, it is a false idea that a baby in the womb is nothing more than a clump of cells rather than a divinely created image-bearer of God
- Another example: it is a mental disorder for a man to believe that he is a woman called Gender Dysphoria
- Our culture has rejected God's love and truth and He has sent them a strong delusion as a punishment
- Many of the things we see going on in our culture can be seen as the consequence of God's punishment on those who have rejected His love and truth

- God doesn't promote to the lies that they are believing that's Satan's role God simply causes them to yield themselves fully to what they desire more than Him and His love and truth
- Even though they have sold themselves to the deception to the lie
- We are called to be vessels of God's love and truth to the world Matthew 5:14-16

You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. <sup>15</sup> Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all *who are* in the house. <sup>16</sup> Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

- Those to whom God has sent the strong delusion are not likely to appreciate the light that shines out of your life
- They love the darkness too much to be led out of it
- But never forget, you were once trapped in darkness, and someone let their light shine into your life and God saved you
- Let your light shine!
