Opening Comments

- Welcome to the FUTURE TODAY prophecy meeting
- Historians define periods of time using the term 'age'
- There was the paleolithic age long time ago
- The 'Middle Ages' were about 1300 to 1500
- The 'Space Age' began the year I was born
- Today we are living in the post-COVID-19 age
- Turn to Matthew 16
- Religion breaks history down into ages also
- There isn't enough time to describe them all to you
- Our focus is the one we are living in We refer to it as the Church Age
- The word church occurs 110 times in the New Testament
- The first occurrence is found in a fascinating conversation Jesus has with His disciples
- <u>Matthew 16:13-17</u>
- Jesus is the Christ the Messiah the Savior of the World
- He is the Son of the living God God in the flesh
- Peter didn't figure that out God revealed it to him
- Then Christ speaks of the church
- Matthew 16:18
- Elsewhere the Bible teaches that Jesus is the chief cornerstone of the church, and the apostles and prophets are the foundation and believers are the living stones
- The church is comprised of all people who put their trust in the finished work of Jesus Christ
- When did the church age begin?
- Turn to Acts 2
- Was it here when Jesus said He would build it?
- Was it when Jesus died on the cross for the sins of the whole world?
- Was it after the resurrection when Jesus appeared to the disciples John 20:21-22

THE FUTURE TODAY! Acts 2:1-4 – The Church Age!

So Jesus said to them again, "Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you." ²² And when He had said this, He breathed on *them*, and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit.

- The most common opinion is found here in Acts 2
- Jesus has ascended back to heaven and the disciples gather
- <u>Acts 2:1-4</u>
- Peter stands up in front of the crowd of thousands that gathers and preaches a Spirit-filled message that stirs the hearts of many

• <u>Acts 2:40-41</u>

• Jesus told us what the purpose of the church is **Matthew 28:18-20** And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. ¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and Io, I am with you always, *even* to the end of the age." Amen.

- Notice the phrase, 'the end of the age'
- Every age has a beginning and an end
- The church age will end when the church is no longer on the earth
- We don't know when the end of the church will come Matthew 24:36-37

But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, but My Father only. ³⁷ But as the days of Noah *were,* so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.

- But we know how it will end Jesus will come and snatch everyone who believes in Him out of the world suddenly
- What should the church be doing while it waits for Jesus Matthew 24:42; 44

Watch therefore, for you do not know what hour your Lord is coming... ⁴⁴ Therefore you also be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.

- If you are a believer in the finished work of Jesus Christ then you are the church not a member of the church, not a part of the church you are the church
- We are living in the church age
- And the signs are all around us that we may be close to the end of the church age
- So, we need to stay ready for Christ to come and get His church you and me and we need to be busy making disciples while we wait
